



GARAWAY EDUCATION FOUNDATION: **2020 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, leadership potential, school and community involvement and possibly a personal interview. Scholarships will be awarded for one year, and are non-renewable unless otherwise noted.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior at Garaway High School.
2. Applicant must be accepted for admission to an accredited institution for higher education (college, university, technical school) that offers an Associate Degree (2-year), Bachelor's Degree (4-year), or 3-year Diploma. We also have one scholarship specified for students attending a trade school.
3. Applicant must have 3 people complete reference forms by Monday, March 2, 2020. References will complete a form via Google forms. Submit your reference names and e-mail addresses to Kelli Troyer in the Central Office as soon as possible for your references to receive the request to complete the Google form. Two references must be from teachers at Garaway High School. The third reference may be a current work or community related reference, a Garaway High School advisor or coach.
4. Applicant must submit a completed application with essay to the Garaway Central Office by Monday, March 9, 2020. Applications are available at www.GarawayEducationFoundation.org. Type in the fillable form and print.
5. Students selected for scholarship awards must present to the Central Office a thank you letter to their scholarship sponsor before funds will be disbursed. If you lose your scholarship check you will be responsible for a \$50 stop payment fee to reissue the check.
